

1. General

- 1.1. The competition is run by Richmonds Plumbing & Heating Merchants Limited (the “**Company**”).
- 1.2. The name of the competition is the Richmonds Results Predictor Competition June/July 2026 (the “**Competition**”).
- 1.3. The Competition will be run in two parts:
 - 1.3.1. the Results Predictor; and
 - 1.3.2. the End Prize.
- 1.4. The Competition will run from Wednesday 10 June 2026 (the “**Opening Date**”) to Saturday 18 July 2026 (the “**Closing Date**”).
- 1.5. All entries must be received by the Company at one of its Branches by no later than 12pm on the Closing Date.
- 1.6. Richmonds Employees are not eligible to enter the Competition.
- 1.7. The Company reserves the right to update or amend these terms and conditions at its sole discretion at any time on or prior to the Closing Date.

2. Results Predictor

- 2.1. To enter the Results Predictor:
 - 2.1.1. the entrant (or the entrant’s business) must make a purchase on each day of entering the Competition at any of our Trade Counters between the Opening Date and the Closing Date; and
 - 2.1.2. the entrant must complete a Results Predictor form, which are available from any of our Trade Counters throughout the Competition.
- 2.2. A Results Predictor form relates to football games on the day following the date of purchase, as specified by the Company.
- 2.3. Subject to clause 2.1, the entrant shall be entitled to one Results Predictor per day.
- 2.4. Entrants who correctly predict the match results will receive the following:
 - 2.4.1. two correct match results wins two cans of beer or fizzy drink, one packet of Pringles crisps and six points for the End Prize; and
 - 2.4.2. one correct match result wins three points for the End Prize (the “**Predictor Prizes**”).
- 2.5. The specific content of the Predictor Prizes is at the sole discretion of the Company and may be subject to change without notice.
- 2.6. There is no cash alternative for the Predictor Prizes.

3. End Prize

- 3.1. End Prize points will be collated by the Company from the Opening Date to the Closing Date.
- 3.2. Points will be collated per Branch and points received from correct Results Predictors completed at one Branch of the Company cannot be transferred to another Branch of the Company.

- 3.3. There will be one winner of the End Prize per Branch. The winner of the End Prize at each Branch will be the entrant with the most points at that Branch on the Closing Date. In the event of a draw between two or more entrants at one Branch, the winner will be drawn at random by the Company.
- 3.4. The winners of the End Prize will be announced by the Company shortly after the Closing Date.
- 3.5. The End Prize is each winner’s choice of Football Shirt, subject to a maximum cost price to the Company of £75 per winner (the “**End Prize**”). In the event of a dispute, the particular style of the End Prize is at the sole discretion of the Company.
- 3.6. Prizes are subject to availability. The Company reserves the right to replace the End Prize with an alternative prize of equal or higher value if it is necessary to do so due to circumstances outside the Company’s control.
- 3.7. There is no cash alternative for the End Prize.

4. Winners

- 4.1. The Company will identify the winners. The Company’s decision is final.
- 4.2. The Company will contact the winners as soon as possible after the Closing Date, using the telephone number and/or email address provided by the entrant on their Results Predictor form.
- 4.3. If a winner cannot be contacted within 14 days of the Closing Date, the Company reserves the right to offer the relevant prize(s) to another entrant of the Competition.

5. Data Protection

- 5.1. The Company will use the name, email address and telephone number provided by the entrant on the Results Predictor form to contact the winners.
- 5.2. The Company uses the personal data provided by the entrant on their Results Predictor form to:
 - 5.2.1. conduct the Competition in accordance these competition terms and conditions; and
 - 5.2.2. as set out in our Privacy and Cookie Policy (a copy of which is available on our website or on request from our Trade Counters).

6. Jurisdiction

- 6.1. The Competition terms and conditions shall be governed by, and construed in accordance with, the laws of Scotland and the entrant(s) and the Company irrevocably agree that the courts of Scotland shall have non-exclusive jurisdiction to settle any dispute or claim arising out of, or in connection with, these Competition terms and conditions, their subject matter or formation (including non-contractual disputes or claims).
